Scholarship Award

- 1. One year membership to NARO/NARO Texas
- 2. Complimentary registration to the NARO Texas Convention in year the award is won.
- 3. Registration paid for enrollment into the Certified Mineral Manager's program at the Associate Level.
- 4. The books recommended by the Certified Mineral Manager's program, Associate Level.

Scholarship Selection Requirements

- 1. The applicant's family must own mineral property or royalties.
- 2. Applicant must be between the ages of 16 to 28 during the year of the scholarship award.
- 3. Applicant must submit a short essay, not more than 2400 words. Essay topics to cover:

- 5. Scholarship winner must be present at the NARO Texas Convention the year the application is made to receive the award.
- 6. Provide updates on your CMM certification progress to the NARO Texas Charlie West Memorial Scholarship Committee, when requested.
- 7. The scholarship recipient must be willing to submit in writing their willingness to complete the Certified Mineral Manager's program until certification is achieved.
- 8. Allow your name to be mentioned in any NARO/NARO Texas publications, website(s) and or social media in conjunction with scholarship promotion.
- 9. The scholarship winner must be willing to attend future NARO Texas conventions.
- 10. Two alternates scholarship winners will be selected each year. In the event the winning candidate is not able to meet the requirements of the award.
- 11. Winning candidates may not apply a second time.

The Scholarship Committee will review all applications and essays and will notify the winner and two alternates by US Mail or email.
